

Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Gallup City Council, City of Gallup, New Mexico, held in the Council Chambers at City Hall, 110 West Aztec, at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 10, 2011.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jackie McKinney.

Councilor Wall made the motion to approve Resolution R2011-21. Seconded by Councilor Enfield. Roll call: Councilors Wall, Enfield, Landavazo, Garcia and Mayor McKinney all voted aye.

### **Comments by Mayor and City Councilors**

Councilor Enfield requested a discussion item at the next Council meeting on the possible ban of certain plastic bags. He would like to have a controlled burn at the Gamarco Wash from Wilson Avenue to the Gallup Flea Market. He also asked the City Manager for an update of the Northside Multi-Generational Center Revitalization Project.

Councilor Wall thanked State Rep. Patty Lundstrom and State Senator George Munoz for their presentations at the last work session. He agreed with Senator Munoz's recommendation to have a contract in place for the actual water for Navajo-Gallup Water Supply Project and to contact Victor Marshall, a water rights consultant, for assistance concerning the project. Councilor Wall reiterated his comments and recommendations from the April 12, 2011 Work Session to have the NGWSP contracts reviewed by Mr. Marshall or by other specialists. Mayor McKinney said he has given the information obtained from Mr. Marshall to Mr. Dible to review.

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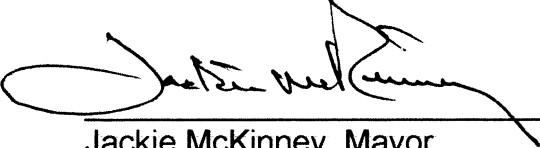
Councilor Landavazo requested a discussion item at the next Council meeting concerning the development of a memorandum of understanding with the County to use and schedule prisoners for the City's community clean-up efforts. He expressed his concerns with not being able to properly schedule prisoners and feels there should be an agreement in place with the County to commit the use of the prisoners. Councilor Enfield agreed with Councilor Landavazo and said he and John Allen, Deputy Police Chief, have tried to address the issue with jail officials; however, prisoners are continually scheduled for work detail and are not being transported to work sites. Mr. Dible said he would like to present options for the Mayor and Councilors to consider at the next Council meeting to address community clean-up issues.

Mayor McKinney thanked and commended Mr. Pederson for serving as Acting City Manager during the past fourteen months.
